- Has a God-given desire to help change the lives of troubled teens and enjoys working with teenagers;
- Experience working with residential school teens or youth programs with at-risk teens;
- Educational, spiritual leadership, interpersonal communications, counseling, etc.;
- Willingness to work under the authority of the School Ranch Program Director
(A minimum of two (2) years commitment is required.)

This is a great opportunity for a qualified individual who would enjoy the challenge of helping to implement the initial Agape Youth Ranch 12-month Residential School Program for "at-risk" teens within the parameters of the AYM vision.
