- *Short Term and Long-Term Internship Program The student leadership program is approximately a three year program and the Board set a per student cost of \$7,560.00 shared three ways by the student, local Community Youth Group, (CYG) and AYM Scholarship program

The Board approves the STUDENT LEADERSHIPS (SLP) INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

We have some students with the White Mountain Youth Student Leadership Program that will qualify for the SLP Internship program. Following is an over view of the program **Student Qualification**

- *Acknowledge Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior
- *Continue committed relationship with Christ
- *Interest in helping Youth grow in Christ
- *Completed or participating in SLP programs

Student Expectation Short term or Long-Term Internship (3 month to 9 month)

- *Be punctual at all institutions, activities, meetings ,etc. t*Do all weekly reading assignments.
- *Acquainted with inner workings of accepting institution
- *Develop relationships with students involved in programs *Be flexible, self-starter, problem solver team player, etc.
- *Do daily journal
- *Be polite and courteous to everyone.
- *Always have something with you to take notes.
- *Follow tasks and assignments given to you.
- *Participate in all ministry events; VBS, retreats, etc.

AYM Scholarship Program Revised

The Board also approved revising the AYM Scholarship program that would provide for students not involved in a Board of Directors Home Church's or a community youth group. Maximum Scholarship per student was set at \$200.

New Valley of the Son coordinators and programs

Board approves new Valley of the Son coordinators, Jim Tripodi and Bev Buddee, and funding to establish and promote a Valley of the Son event in the NE Phoenix valley for this Spring. Also, in the works is researching the establishment of a Dig Deeper Bible School in the NE Phoenix valley.

Board sets Budget for 2022

The Board approved administrative cost, that will be financially, supported by the Board. Doner funding will be used for AYM's/CYG programs

- *Funding for the Student Leadership Program was approved, providing shared funding thru AYM's Scholarship Program.
- *Support funding for Community youth Groups and their events was also approved. Which includes:
 - *WMY Bible Jeopardy event, Air soft Tournament, and a Apologetics Conference.
 - *Valley of the Son spring community Youth Group event and establishment of a Dig Deeper Bible School..
 - *Funding to review and up-date AYM's marketing program
